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My Personal Perspective on Korea

- 3 years with a Korean law firm in the late 1980s -when Korea was an "emerging market"
- Returned to New York in 1990 and published an article on Korea's liberalization of trade and investment, but began to appreciate the issues beyond sector openings holding back Korean trade and investment
 - For example, while with a New York law firm, we represented a global cosmetics company in its fight for survival in an industry sector that had been technically liberalized
